




A is for apple, so yummy to eat.



B is for bees, that make honey so sweet.






C is for cat.

G is for goat. He's eating a snack.




H is for hats.

J is for apple juice, oh, so nice.




K is for keys.

It's wild and it roars!






M is for moon.

N is for bird's nest, on a branch way up high.






O is for owl, a bird of the night.

Q is for quilt, with patches so bright.




R is for rabbit.

It grows very tall!




U is for umbrella used in rain showers.






V is for vase filled with beautiful flowers.

This one is Joan's.






X is for x-ray.
